

Frequently Asked Questions

Dr. Ambedkar National Merit Award Scheme for senior Secondary Examination

1. What is this Scholarship?

This is Dr. Ambedkar National Merit Award Scheme for Senior Secondary Examination (Second Year PUC) to be given to Meritorious Students belonging to Scheduled Castes(S.C)

2. Who will give this Scholarship?

Dr. Ambedkar's Foundation, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.

3. Who are Eligible for this Scholarship?

Three top students belonging to Scheduled Caste scoring highest marks in the Second Year P.U Examination conducted by Department of P.U Education are eligible for this Scholarship. This Scholarship will be given stream wise. Hence, there will be a total of 12 Scholarships.

4. What is the Scholarship amount to be given

Student scoring Highest Marks	Rs. 60,000
Student scoring 2 nd Highest Marks	Rs. 50,000
Student scoring 3 rd Highest Marks	Rs. 40,000

In addition to these three students, three girls who secure the highest marks after the first three positions of merit will be given a special award of Rs. 20,000 each.

5. Who will select the students for this Scholarship?

The Department of P.U Education will select the students and send the list to the Dr. Ambedkar Foundation. They would process the same and approve it.

6. How will this be disbursed?

The award amount shall be sent to the student awardees directly in the forms of an Account Payee Bank Draft by registered post under intimation to the Department of P.U Education.

7. Will there be a function to present these awards?

Sometimes there will be a felicitation function to be held at New Delhi. The foundation may invite the awardees. If there is no function it shall be sent through the respective Deputy Commissioners. In case the foundation invites the students to felicitation function, the awardee and one escort will be paid actual fare by sleeper class train from the place of study or home town. (both ways)
