

CIRCULAR

Subject: Conduct of various competitions for the students – Essay writing, Collage making, Poster making, National Quiz regarding.

ECI has directed to establish Electoral Literacy Clubs (ELCs) and Chunavana Pathashalas (CPs) in the schools and colleges for creating awareness among the future voters. The guidelines and instructions were given for establishing ELCs and CPs in the schools and colleges. It was also informed to constitute District and Taluk level committees for effective functioning of the ELCs and CPs and organising activities and competitions at all levels related to the components of Democracy, Electoral and Voting processes. The State Level Master Trainers workshop was held from 26-27 July 2018 at the CEO Office, Bangalore. The Resource materials are being translated and planned for organising training programs for Resource Persons at different levels the district and block level and conveners of the ELCs and CPs).

Every year on 25th January National Voters Day is being celebrated. On that day, new voters are issued EPICs and information about various electoral processes are shared with the public especially the public at large. As part of NVD please have competitions for classes IX and above. Last year there were competitions for Essay writing, Collage making, Poster making and Quiz competitions. The students may be briefed in advance and suitable subjects may be given. These competitions shall be conducted at all schools, PU colleges and ITIs. The following suggested topics may be considered.
