Dhirubhai Ambani Undergraduate Scholarship Scheme For Physically Challenged Category

1. The Scholarship Scheme :

- 1.1 "Dhirubhai Ambani Undergraduate Scholarship Scheme" for the physically challenged meritorious students of Std XII State Education Board Examinations is in force in the States of Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa and the Union Territory of Daman, Diu and Dadra Nagar Haveli since 1999 on district wise basis. From 2002 the Scheme has been extended to the rest of India on State-wise basis.
- 1.2. **Objective of the Scheme :** To give recognition to the physically challenged students who achieve academic excellence at Std. XII Examination of the State Education Boards and give equal opportunity to them to secure profession oriented education in vocations leading to degree/diploma that will enhance the potential of national human resource.

2. Nature of Scholarship :

- 2.1 The amount of the scholarship will depend upon the nature of education for which the student has secured admission, in accordance with and subject to, the maximum stipulated at 2.2 and shall comprise:
- 2.1.1 Reimbursement of education fees paid to the college/institution/university, on submission of the fees receipt.
- 2.1.2 Allowance for purchase of books and educational material.
- 2.1.3 Allowance for maintenance including hostel/accommodation and transport.

2.2 Amount of Scholarship payable under the Scheme:

3. Eligibility Conditions :

- 3.1 For Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa and Daman, Diu and Dadra Nagar Haveli, from each district, the student securing the highest overall percentage of marks under the Physically Challenged Category at the Std. XII examination of the State Board of Education conducted in March each year will be eligible to receive the Scholarship. The maximum number of Scholarships will be restricted to one per district.

3.2 **For the rest of India**, (excluding Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa and Daman, Diu and Dadra Nagar Haveli), from each State the first five students and from each Union Territory the first three students under the Physically Challenged Category at the Std. XII examination of the State Board of Education conducted in March each year will be eligible to receive the Scholarship.

The total number of Scholarships per state/union territory will be decided by the Foundation depending upon the population and the number of districts in each of the states and union territories of India.

3.3 The student should be below 20 years of age as on April 30 of the year he / she appears for the Std. XII examination and should have secured minimum of 40% average marks in the examination.

3.4 If two or more students secure the same percentage of marks, the selection will be decided by the higher percentage of marks secured in the core subjects of the stream chosen by the students. In case of a tie, the marks secured at Std X State Board examination will be considered, failing which, the alphabetical order of their surnames will decide the award of the scholarship.

4. Selection of Candidates :

4.1 On receipt of the results of the Std. XII examination from the Board, the Foundation shall send the application forms to students prima facie eligible.

4.2 The students may return the completed forms within 7 days from the receipt thereof, to the following address:

4.3 Please note that the application forms must be accompanied by the certified true copies of mark lists of Std X and XII Board examinations and the certificate of disability. Affixing of the latest passport size colour photograph of the student on the application form is absolutely essential.

4.4 The application form received shall be scrutinized to confirm the student's eligibility and the selected candidates shall be intimated accordingly.

5. Duration and Continuation :

5.1 The Scholarship shall be awarded on yearly basis for the entire duration of the degree/ diploma / course opted for by the student, subject to the following conditions:

5.1.1 The student should maintain consistent standard of academic progress by securing not less than 50% marks or equivalent grades (average of both semesters) in the examinations conducted by the college/institution/university for each academic year.

If a student fails to maintain such consistency for reasons beyond his/her control, such as ill health, accident or any other satisfactory reasons, the Foundation may consider continuation of the Scholarship, stipulating such conditions as may be deemed appropriate.

5.1.2 If the students fails in the examination or is rusticated / expelled / debarred from appearing for any examination from the college/institution/university, the Scholarship shall be stopped.

6. The Scheme may be amended/changed from time to time or withdrawn partially or altogether without any notification, at the discretion of the Foundation. In the event of any difference or dispute as to the interpretation of the Scheme or selection of the students for the Scholarships, the decision of the Foundation shall be final and binding on all.
